After Reading and discussing the module 2 we agreed some guidelines regarding the communication with the students:

- When sending off a student, we will make sure that straight away we establish a communication with him/her:
 - Describe concisely what has upset without judging
 - Find out the context in which it was produced
 - Comment to those most affected
 - Always keep a positive role, no matter the student attitude
 - Remind other moments in which the student had correct behavior.
 - Agree specific changes with the student.

This has happened and has been applied. Show respect to conflictive students helps to a better communication with them.

Module 3:

We have found Chapters 2 and 3 specially interesting. Soe of the teachers has applied in the class room collaborative learning methodologies mentioned like the “expert groups”, where the students have to prepare well what they have to explain to the others. With reference to chapter 3 the tutors, together with the guidance team, have hold collective meetings with different students with similar behaviour of learning problems. They looked for a solution together. This way the process of looking for a solution enriched everybody. The steps are:

- Define the problem
- Search of solutions



- Suggestions from the students (what do they want to change)
- Definition of the goal
