

The initiative was born keeping in mind that a lot of students attending the first year of the secondary education meet big difficulties when studying individually and when executing and organizing their own homework. This problematic situation sometimes leads both to scholastic failure and early school leaving. For this reason a work-team is instituted; it involves first classes teachers that work in order to facilitate suitable behaviours and good methods in order to help students studying at home.

Aims:

- letting all teachers know about the level of preparation of each student
- identifying the students who have scholastic deficiencies in order to consolidate their own learning abilities
- improving meta-cognitive skills
- bettering free-time organization

Instruments:

- assisted learning
- individual relationship



The teacher helps in:

Teachers work in more than one way: they apply both cognitive meta-cognitive and motivational methods.

Teachers give any useful information to the students whenever they think it is necessary:

- explanation of the tasks
- how to apply rules and any sequences of operations
- how to select helpful information about the execution of a task
- how to do and use schemes and maps
- how to organize the notes taken during morning lessons
- how to use multimedia techniques
- evaluation of any done-actions and sharing of results during each staff meeting.
